Welcome to the 2023 Annual General Meeting of the Chimo Gymnastics Club.

This year the club continued to work on covid recovery strategies. We increased the number of school programs we brought through the facility, introduced a satellite program in Black Creek and used the services of a behaviour specialist to train coaches in coaching neurotypical learners.
